**REQUEST FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT
AND INTERNATIONAL COORDINATION**

As discussed in the accompanying "Narrative Statement," Motorola is actively involved in the research and development of hardware and software solutions for the public safety and homeland security community and is continually engaged in the design and development of a new and innovative communications equipment. The experimental authority requested herein will allow the company to test the performance of these devices, to demonstrate their operation and functionality to persons involved in public safety and homeland security activities, and to determine user acceptability.

Motorola was recently asked to conduct a demonstration of prototype equipment for the City and the County of San Diego during the International Association of Chiefs of Police Conference to be held in San Diego on November 8-12, 2008. In preparation for that demonstration, Motorola also seeks authority to conduct preliminary tests at its facilities in Sterling, Illinois. Motorola proposes to commence these tests on **November 1, 2008**.

Accordingly, Motorola respectfully requests expedited treatment of its request for special temporary authority ("STA") so that it may commence the demonstration in a timely fashion as requested. Motorola is unable to re-schedule the test, as representatives attending the demonstration conference cannot readily participate at another time. In addition, Motorola seeks to provide actual test data at the meetings to be held during the weeks following the conference.

In particular, Motorola respectfully requests that FCC staff expedite any required international coordination of this application. The proposed operation in San Diego is near the border with Mexico, and Motorola anticipates that additional procedures might apply or delays might occur in connection with such coordination. Initiating the process as soon as possible might help ensure timely action on this matter.

Motorola submits that expedited processing of its request for an STA is in the public interest, convenience, and necessity, as it will permit Motorola to develop innovative equipment that will accommodate the communications needs of the public safety and homeland security community and, ultimately, the public.
