Special Conditions:

- (1) Prior to equipment authorization or a determination of compliance, the device must be accompanied by a conspicuous notice worded as follows: "This device has not been authorized as required by the rules of the Federal Communications Commission. This device is not, and may not be, offered for sale or lease, or sold or leased, until authorization is obtained."
- (2) Any operation in these bands must be coordinated with the existing and future users to avoid interference. Emission types may vary under the experiment.
- (3) Operation is subject to prior coordination with affected Educational Broadband Service/Broadband Radio Service (EBS/BRS) licensees.
- (4) Operation in the 1850-1910 or 1930-1990 MHz band requires prior frequency coordination with 2 GHz microwave users and consent of PCS licensees to avoid interference.
- (5) Operation in the 824-849 or 869-894 MHz band requires consent of local cellular licensee(s) to avoid interference.
- (6) Operation is subject to prior coordination with the Associated Public Safety Communications Officers, Inc. (APCO); ATTN: Director of Frequency Coordination; 351 North Williamson Blvd.; Daytona Beach, FL 32114-1112; Telephone: (386) 322-2500.
- (7) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (8) Operation in the 1710-1755 or 2110-2155 MHz band requires consent of local Advanced Wireless Service (AWS) licensee(s) to avoid interference.
- (9) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (10) NO market studies may be conducted under this authorization without further approval.
- (11) Licensee is authorized to operate up to 10 base stations and 200 mobile units for each individual experiment. Licensee shall not operate more than 50 base stations and 750 mobiles for all experiments combined under this authorization. Operation of additional base stations and mobile units must be requested with sufficient justification.
- (12) Licensee is authorized under Section 5.75 to test, demonstrate and operate prototype products in the above frequency bands. Licensee is required to notify the Commission of the specific details of each individual experiment, including location, number of base and mobile units, power, emission designator, and any other pertinent technical information. No operation shall take place until the Commission has received the required notification. This notification should be uploaded electronically via the OET Experimental Licensing Branch's Electronic Filing Web Site at https://gulfoss2.fcc.gov/prod/oet/index_els.html using the "Add Attachments" feature.
- (13) Operation in the band 1910-1930 MHz is subject to prior coordination with existing and future fixed microwave service licensees in accordance with 47 CFR, Part 101.103(d).
