Special Conditions:

- (1) Operation in the 1850-1910 or 1930-1990 MHz band requires prior frequency coordination with 2 GHz microwave users and consent of PCS licensees to avoid interference.

Special Conditions:

- (2) The station identification requirements of Section 5.115 of the Commission's Rules are waived.
- (3) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (4) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (5) All use on frequencies assigned to public safety licensees should be coordinated with the designated land mobile public safety coordinator.
- (6) All use on frequencies that are assigned for use by stations in the fixed microwave service should be prior coordinated with existing operations in accordance with Section 101.103(d).
- (7) All use on frequencies that are assigned for use by stations the broadcast auxiliary service should be coordinated with the local broadcast coordinator.
- (8) Operation on this assignment is subject to immediate cessation, if it causes harmful interference to FAA operations within frequency bands 932-935 MHz and 941-944MHz.
