Modification of XE Experimental License WK2XOZ
ELS File No. 0162-EX-CM-2026

REQUEST FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT

As discussed in the accompanying “Narrative Statement,” Motorola Solutions, Inc. (“MSI”) respectfully requests a modification of its Export Only (“XE”) conventional experimental license issued under call sign WK2XOZ, which authorizes MSI to conduct low power testing of base station and subscriber devices indoors within its facilities. Its current license authorizes such operations at MSI facilities located in Elgin, Illinois (Location No. 1), and Allen, Texas (Location No. 2). In the instant application, MSI seeks a modification of its license to conduct operations almost identical to those authorized under Location No. 2 at pits new facilities recently constructed in Plantation, Florida (proposed Location No. 3).

As noted in its Narrative Statement, MSI has been developing certain equipment to meet the requirements of a foreign government entities, and one of those entities has asked MSI to commence tests at its new location in Plantation by **August 3, 2026**, so that the entity may evaluate the performance and functionality of equipment prior to export. This change in schedule is completely out of the control of MSI and is based on the entity’s urgent need for the equipment to meet immediate and critical public safety communications needs. Moreover, the entity’s evaluation requirements cannot be met at MSI’s other authorized test locations authorized under call sign WK2XOK at Elgin, Illinois or Allen, Texas.

Accordingly, MSI respectfully seeks expedited processing of this application so that it may commence operations at the Plantation site on or before August 3, 2026. Given that MSI’s proposed activities will be conducted completely indoors and the devices will be operated at very low power levels, it is MSI’s understanding that this application is eligible for an exemption from review and coordination by the Interdepartmental Radio Advisory Committee (“IRAC”), as MSI believes was the case in connection with its previous application for this call sign, submitted under ELS File No. 0124-EX-CM-2023, covering its site at Allen, Texas. A similar exemption applied here would serve the public interest by facilitating expedited processing of its application to meet the critical public safety communications needs described in this “Request for Expedited Treatment.”

MSI submits that expedited processing of its application is in the public interest, convenience, and necessity, as it will allow MSI to meet the requirements of a foreign government entity to meet its immediate and critical public safety communications needs.
