Special Conditions:

- (1) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (2) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (3) The station identification requirements of Section 5.115 of the Commission's Rules are waived.
- (4) Maintain operation separation from the grandfathered earth stations as defined in Part 90, Sub-part Z, or coordinate an agreement with the grandfathered earth station licensees prior to operation in 3650-3700 MHz band.
- (5) Consult the ULS database to ensure that the operation will not cause harmful interference to any existing registered stations in the 3650-3700 MHz band, and notify the registered users in the proposed geographic areas.
- (6) Licensee be aware that FSS earth stations are licensed above 3700 MHz and if any interference occurs, the experimental licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
