For 0899-EX-CN-2019, Motorola Solutions Inc. (Motorola Solutions) seeks a 60 month term pursuant to Section 5.71(a) of the FCC's Rules. As explained in the Narrative Statement submitted with the application, the requested experimental authority is needed in order to allow Motorola Solutions to test, calibrate and perform proof of performance certification of production equipment prior to shipment. The tested devices are all manufactured for export or for U.S. Federal Agency use and are therefore not subject to the FCC's equipment approval process. Under Section 2.805(b), an experimental license is needed to authorize the operation of unapproved devices even within the manufacturing facility.

Motorola Solutions fully expects to continue the production of products operating pursuant to the requested parameters in the experimental application for the foreseeable future. Therefore, the need for experimental authority to test unapproved devices will extend beyond 60 months. A 60 month term would obviate the need for a premature renewal and is therefore simply a matter of convenience and efficiency for both Motorola Solutions and FCC processing staff.
