Just wanted to write and follow-up on the documentation I sent you yesterday afternoon in reference to the 700 MHz Emergency Back-up System for the OAS (Organization of American States) Conference. Just wanted to know if you had looked it over as well as to see if there were any questions or concerns regarding our system and its operation.

As mentioned earlier we are in the process of applying for temporary license with the FCC. The event is scheduled for the first week of June and testing is scheduled for the beginning of May. We were also able to attain a letter of consent from CH63 giving us permission to operate under our requested frequencies. (Letter is attached)

We just received word from our FCC Contact that our application needs to be submitted for approval by this Thursday to be able to have the STA just in time for us to test the system as scheduled in May.
