1. Added a request to operate the nanosatellites on the 2.4 – 2.48 GHz frequencies. Please note that only the satellites, not the earth stations, will transmit on this frequency. Please also note that we are separately seeking authority to operate on the 2.4 – 2.48 GHz frequencies on an unlicensed basis, and we include this experimental request in an abundance of caution.
2. Added a request to operate an earth station in Chelmsford, Massachusetts. This additional earth station is otherwise identical to the other earth stations in the application.
