For Operations on Channel E1 in Boston, MA from October 24 – 29, 2005**

Dear Sir or Madam:

Nextel Spectrum Acquisition Corp., a wholly-owned subsidiary of Sprint Nextel Corporation (collectively "Sprint Nextel") is the licensee of Broadband Radio Service ("BRS") Stations B051 and WMI863. Stations B051 and WMI863 have geographic service areas covering Boston, Massachusetts and have channel assignments including Channel E1 (2596 – 2602 MHz).

Sprint Nextel hereby concurs with the associated request for Special Temporary Authority ("STA") filed by Navini Networks ("Navini"). Navini requests the STA to allow for operations on Broadband Radio Service Channel E1 during a WiMAX show scheduled from October 24 through October 29, 2005, at the Boston Seaport Hotel and Boston World Trade Center in Boston Massachusetts. Sprint Nextel and Navini will coordinate their respective operations on Channel E1 to ensure there is no interference to either party.
