**Re: Navini Networks request for Special Temporary Authority
For Operations on Channel H1 in Las Vegas, NV, April 26 – 28, 2006**

Dear Sir or Madam:

SuperChannels of Las Vegas, Inc., a wholly-owned subsidiary of Sprint Nextel Corporation (collectively "Sprint Nextel") is the licensee of Broadband Radio Service ("BRS") Station B245 and the lessee of BRS Station WNTH951-L1. Stations B245 and WNTH951-L1 have geographic service areas covering Las Vegas, Nevada and have channel assignments including Channel H1 (2650 – 2656 MHz).

Sprint Nextel hereby concurs with the associated request for Special Temporary Authority ("STA") filed by Navini Networks ("Navini"). Navini requests the STA to allow for operations on Broadband Radio Service Channel H1 during a WiMAX show scheduled from April 26 through April 28, 2006, at Caesars Palace, 3570 Las Vegas Boulevard, South, Las Vegas, Nevada. Navini will operate with an EIRP under one watt inside Caesars Palace. Sprint Nextel and Navini will coordinate their respective operations on Channel H1 to ensure there is no interference to either party.
