Here is the email from Sam at the FCC. Initially it sounded like we were going to need to file spacecap for the primary mission for which the S-band kill command is included, but there was a miscommunication and Sam clarified that none of the primary missions short duration tx or rx need to be included in our spacecap. This applies to both sherpas on the mission. Thus, the tx from your ground station will not be included in our spacecap, at the request of the fcc and itu.
