Re: Quiet Zone Notification for 3650-3700 MHz Base Station Sites Proposed in the Territory of Puerto Rico

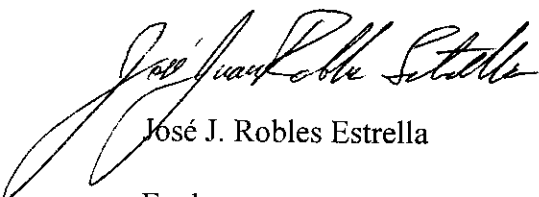
Dear Sir or Madam:

Pursuant to Part 1.924(d)¹ of the Federal Communications Commission's ("FCC") rules, Neptuno Networks, Inc. ("Neptuno") hereby notifies the Arecibo Observatory of its proposed 3650-3700 MHz wireless broadband base stations in the Territory of Puerto Rico.

Neptuno has received a nationwide license to provide broadband services in the 3650-3700 MHz band under Part 90.1307 of the FCC's rules.² No later than February 1, 2008, Neptuno intends to register multiple wireless base stations under this license; all registrations will be located in the Territory of Puerto Rico. Under Part 1.924(d) of the FCC's rules, Neptuno is required to notify the Observatory of any proposed operations in Puerto Rico and provide the technical parameters of operation. This letter should serve as notification and the attached FCC Form 601, Schedule M contains the relevant technical parameters of the proposed operations at 3650-3700 MHz in Puerto Rico.

Neptuno understands that it must be a good spectral neighbor and take reasonable efforts to protect the Observatory from interference.
