RE: Complaint of Unauthorized Use of Radio Spectrum

Dear Mr. Casey:

Islandet, Inc. ("Islandet"), by and through its attorneys, and pursuant to Section 1.41 of the Commission's rules, hereby submits this Supplement to the Complaint filed by Islandet on May 12, 2006 (the "Complaint"), which demonstrated that Neptuno Networks, Inc. ("Neptuno"), is using spectrum to provide broadband wireless service in certain portions of the 5 GHz band for which it has no authorization, and has illegally modified equipment that is not certified to operate in the new U-NII spectrum band.

Attached hereto is a Supplement to the Complaint, prepared by Islandet, in which additional evidence is provided to support the Complaint. Specifically, Islandet has located an additional two locations where Neptuno is using spectrum for which unlicensed operations is not authorized, and two other locations where the new U-NII spectrum band (5.470 - 5.725 GHz) is being used by Neptuno with equipment that has yet to be certified for use in this band. As noted in the complaint, neither Neptuno nor Axxcelera, the manufacturer of the equipment used by Neptuno, has received equipment authorizations for the new U-NII band. *See Complaint, Exhibits C & D.*

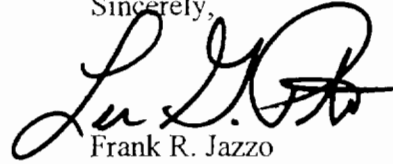
In light of this new information, which, combined with the Complaint demonstrates a blatant evisceration of the Commission's rules and policies, Islandet requests that the Commission immediately launch a full-scale investigation into the operations of Neptuno Networks. Moreover, if such illegal use of spectrum is verified by the Commission's staff, Islandet respectfully requests that the Commission utilize its powers under the Communications Act to order Neptuno to immediately cease all operations until it can be verified that Neptuno is using only that spectrum for which its use is authorized.

Overview

Islanet Communications, Inc. learned that a competing service provider, Neptuno Networks, Inc. (herein referred to as "Neptuno") appeared to be using frequencies not available under Part 15 of the FCC rules. As this would give Neptuno an unfair competitive advantage (using frequencies essentially free from interference, as all unlicensed operators have to contend with), employees of Islanet, Inc. explored the inappropriate usage of these licensed frequencies in the Mayaguez, Puerto Rico area, per guidance provided by Waterford Consultants, LLC, which was retained by Islanet in the initial exploration of the illegal use of licensed frequencies in the San Juan metropolitan area.

On 11 May 2006, Islanet employees experienced in RF engineering, signal surveillance, and direction finding were dispatched to the Mayaguez area to conduct field measurements and document any improper frequency usage.

Equipment

An Anritsu MS2721A portable spectrum analyzer, serial number 545052, possessing a frequency range of 100 KHz – 7 GHz, was used to record frequency occupancy. The analyzer was last calibrated on 8 November 2005 with a calibration due date of 8 November 2006.

An LPA-6000 highly-directional log periodic antenna (LPA), with a frequency range of 2100 – 6000 MHz, nominal gain of 5 dB, and a high front-to-back ratio was used at the input of the analyzer. A 20' low-loss RF coaxial cable was used to facilitate pointing the antenna toward observed signals of interest. Since absolute signal strength was not the subject of this investigation, no attempt to calibrate antenna gain or line gain/loss was performed; thus only relative measurements of signal-to-noise ratios (SNRs) and baseband noise floors were captured.



Field Results

The attached Table 1, Improper Frequencies in Use, documents the results of visits to two sites in the Mayaguez, Puerto Rico area.

Additionally, all signals listed in Table 1 were sufficiently strong as to verify their transmission from the immediate site and respective antennas/emitters.

No attempt was made to demodulate the signals in order to determine which operator may have been responsible; however, in all instances the signals of interest appeared to have bandwidth and modulation characteristics consistent with the 802.11 standard, approximately 20 MHz wide, as depicted on the spectrum analyzer (see attached Figures). Moreover, it was possible to touch the antennas/emitters with the receiving antenna of the spectrum analyzer, and as such, it was possible to ascertain beyond reasonable doubt which antennas/emitters were broadcasting illegally in the licensed frequency bands as depicted in Table 1.

At both sites visited, the following information was acquired: 1) the data obtained was consistent with the field data obtained by Richard P. Biby, Registered Professional Engineer, in his previous report, upon which this Supplement is based; 2) there were frequencies of interest which were being used illegally in the licensed bands; and 3) visual inspection of the feedlines from the antennas/emitters indicated that the transmission and radiation equipment belonged to Neptuno.

Figures 1-4 depict spectrum analyzer screenshots with relevant data points of frequencies and amplitudes of the received signals of interest. Relevant pictures are associated with these screenshots; see below.

Conclusion

From the gathered data, there is substantial evidence that Neptuno is operating in spectra not allowed under the FCC Rules and Regulations. It further appears that these operations are not confined to a single geographic location.

Additionally, visual inspection of the installations indicated that the equipment has been in operation for some time and was not newly installed. Therefore, it is unlikely that Neptuno unintentionally used equipment recently made available for new Part 15, WISP operations. As most WISP equipment allows the user to choose which country's unlicensed spectrum to use, it follows that Neptuno intentionally chose to use RF spectra inconsistent with US and FCC rules and regulations.



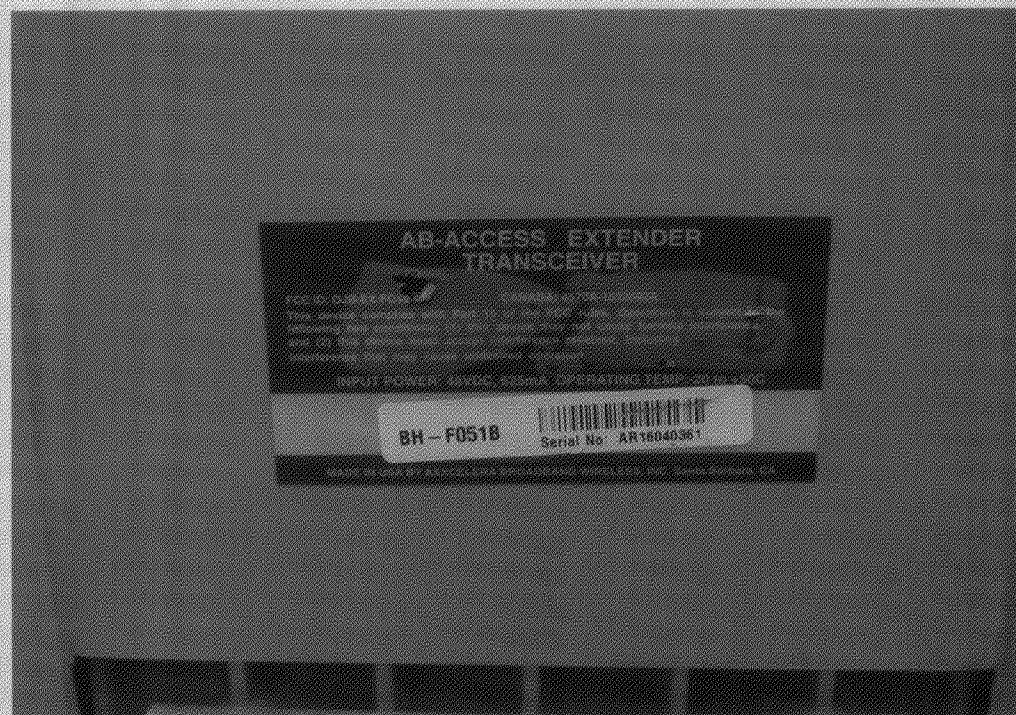
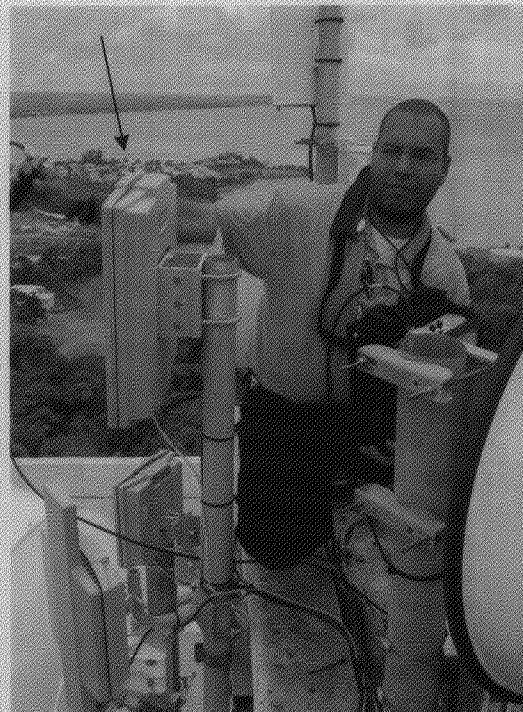
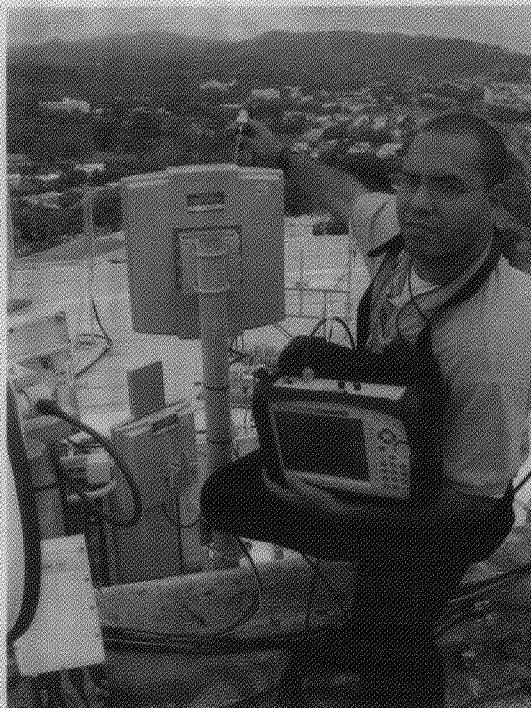
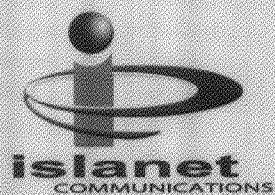

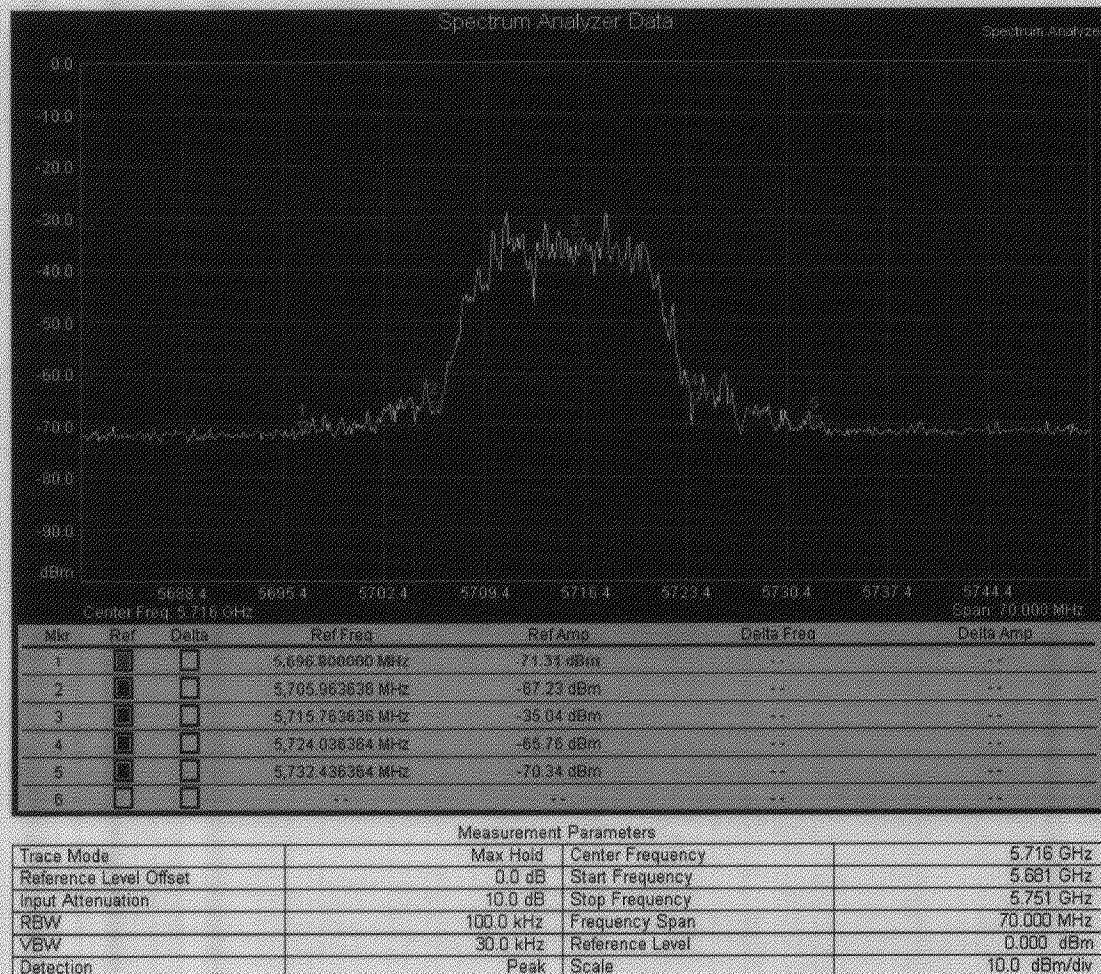
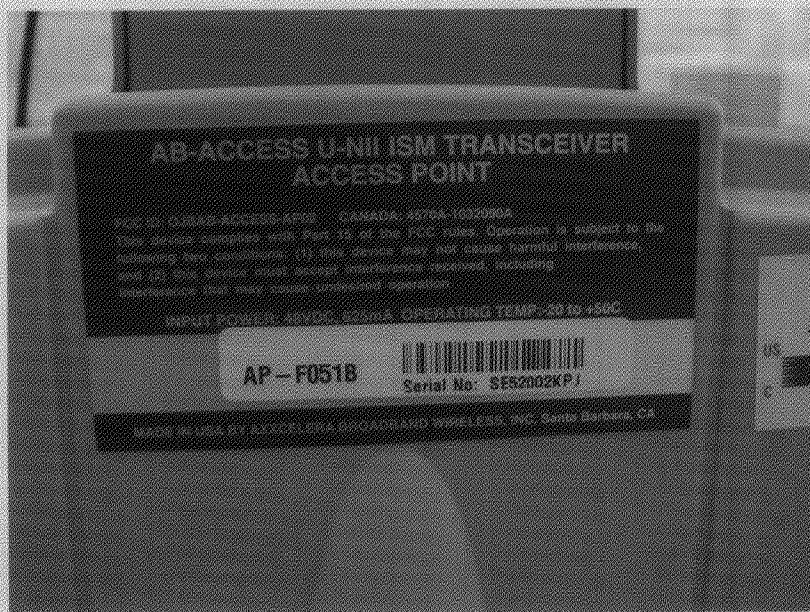
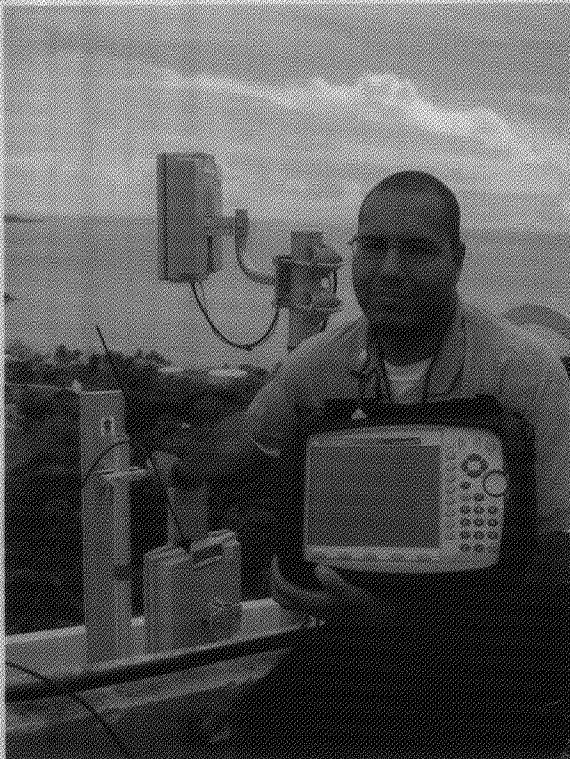


Figure 2 – El Castillo. Emitter #2, 5.696 – 5.732 GHz.



Pictures 2a, 2b – Emitter #2 testing & identification.

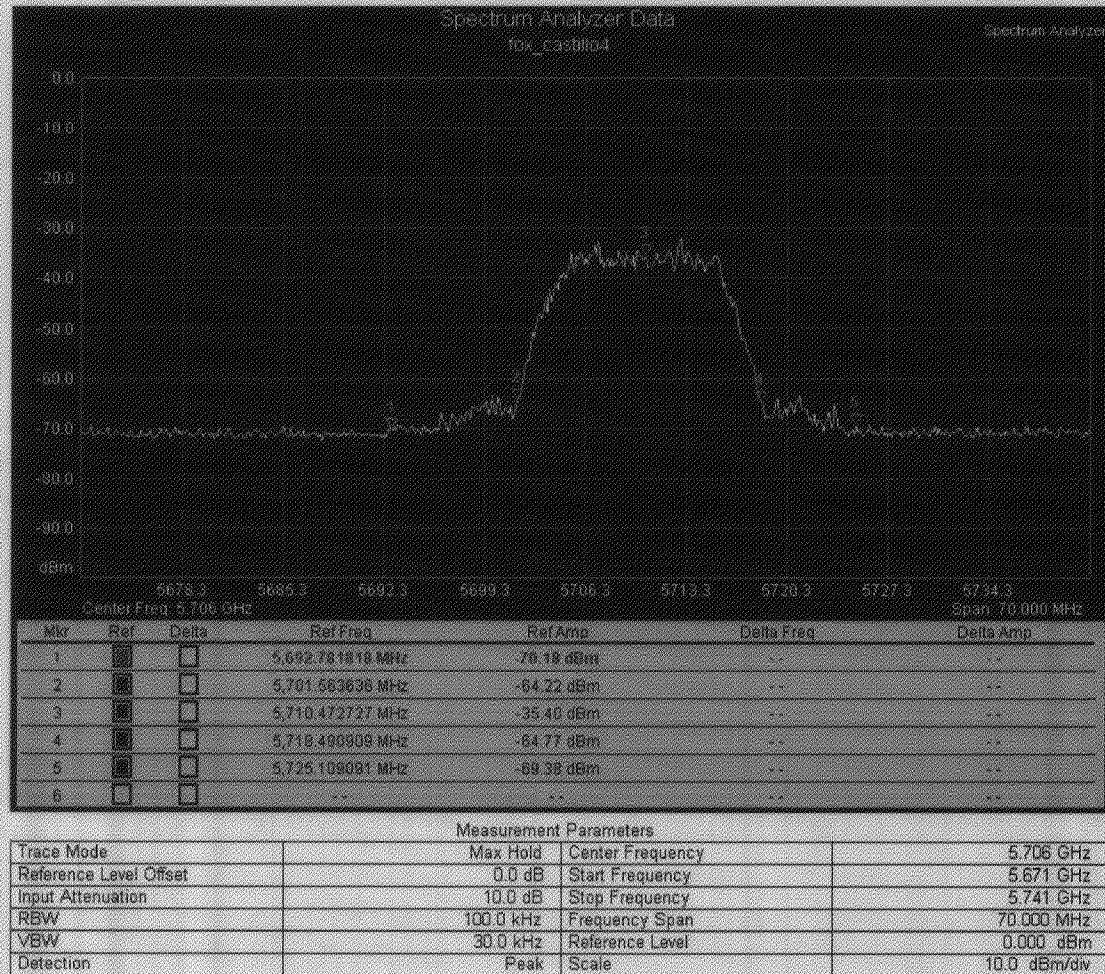
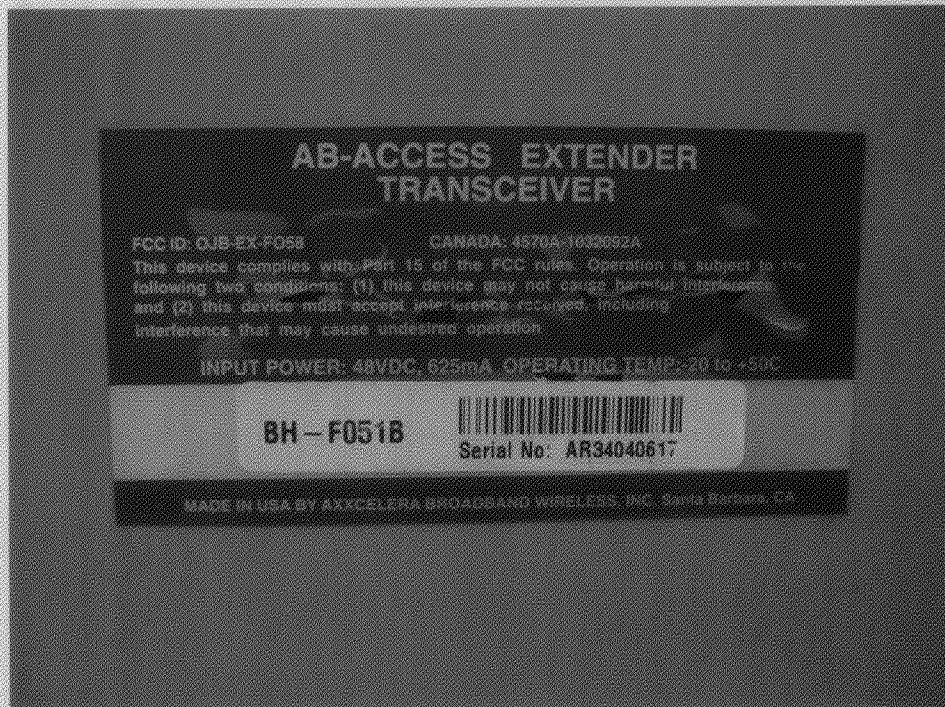
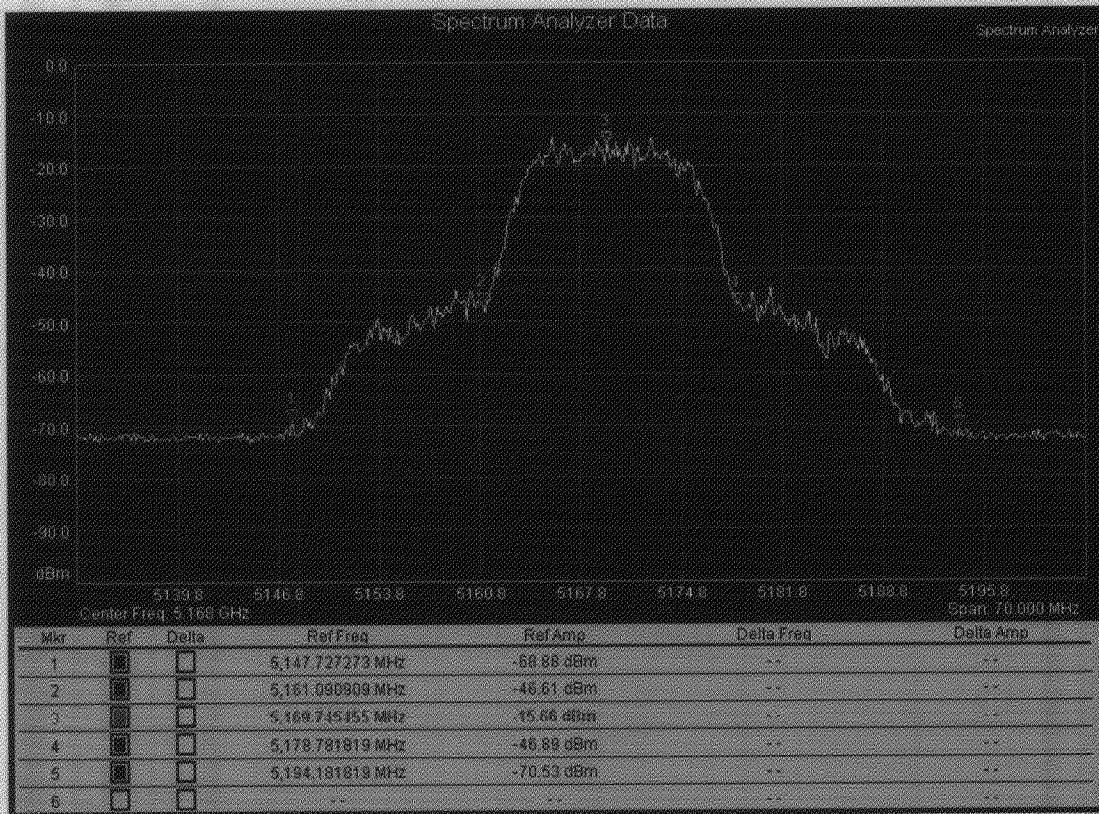


Figure 3 – El Castillo. Emitter #3, 5.694 – 5.724 GHz.

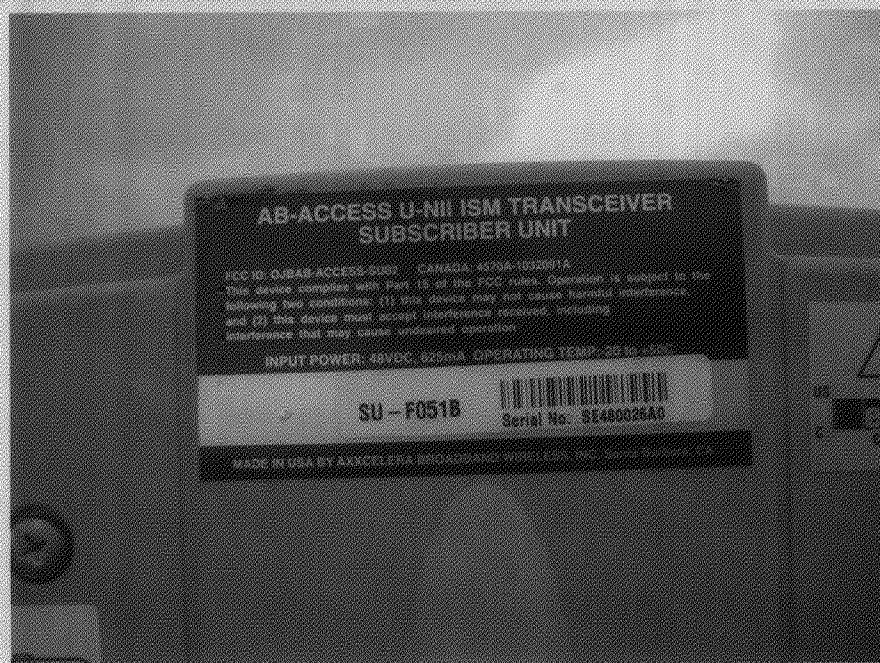


Pictures 3a, 3b - Emitter #3 - testing and identification.
