MOTION REQUESTING WITHDRAWAL OF PETITION

COMES NOW, Neptuno Media, Inc, through its undersigned attorneys,
and respectfully avers and prays as follows:

1. The FCC gave notice to Neptuno Media ("Neptuno") that it allegedly was operating certain equipment in the 5.150 to 5.250 GHz band, in possible violation of FCC standards. Neptuno immediately verified the allegations and identified a series of equipment that it had purchased and that indeed was operating in the abovementioned frequency.

2. On or about June 19, 2006, Neptuno Media ("Neptuno") filed a Request for Special Temporary Authority ("the Request"), in which it petitioned authorization to operate certain devices in the on a temporary basis while it replaced the non-compliant equipment. It was estimated at the time of the petition that the process to replace this equipment would take up to six (6) months.

3. Upon receipt of the FCC's notice, Neptuno embarked in a very aggressive replacement process seeking to remove from operation the offending

equipment as soon as possible. During this process, Neptuno kept in constant contact with the FCC' San Juan Resident Agent, Mr. Reuben Jusino, advising him of the progress of the replacement program.

4. On July 25, 2006, Neptuno informed Mr. Jusino that it had complete the replacement of the non-conforming equipment and that Neptuno's network was in full compliance with the FCC's standards and requirements. Given this situation, and in view of the fact that the Request is still pending review by the FCC, Neptuno desires to withdraw the Request at this time since the dispensation requested is no longer required.

WHEREFORE, it is respectfully requested that Neptuno be allowed to withdraw its Request for Special Temporary Authority and that the case of caption be closed since it has become moot.

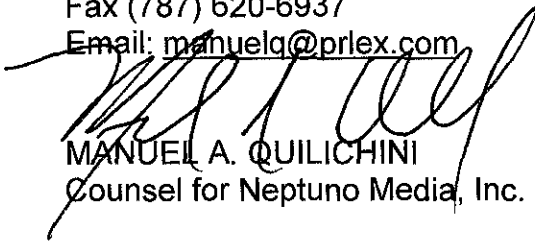

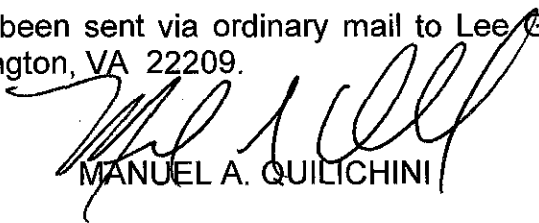
