Special Conditions:

- (1) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (2) The station identification requirements of Section 5.115 of the Commission's Rules are waived.
- (3) Licensee is authorized to use various emissions and bandwidths during the experiment.
- (4) Operation in the 1850-1910 or 1930-1990 MHz band requires prior frequency coordination with 2 GHz microwave users and consent of PCS licensees to avoid interference.
- (5) Within 30 days of consummation of the transfer of control, the Applicants shall notify the Chief, Experimental Licensing Branch, of the date of the consummation. The effective date of this authorization is the later of March 29, 2007 or the date of consummation.
