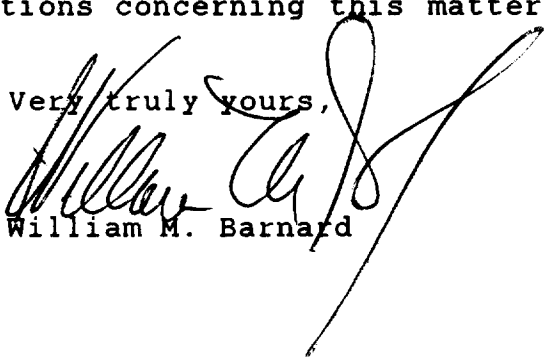

Dear Edward:

This is in reference to your letter dated January 17, 1997 received by Mr. Scott Wendel in regards to your intent to use an experimental license granted by the F.C.C.

From the information you provided New England Wireless on the intended use and frequencies involved, N.E.W. has reviewed the data and we do not anticipate any interference to WMH560 in Lyndonville, Vermont. However, if interference does occur, Signatron Technology must terminate transmission of the interfering signal until such time that the interference can be corrected. At that time New England Wireless will review all additional data on the corrective measures taken to eliminate any interference.

This agreement between New England Wireless and Signatron Technology for the use of experimental license granted by the F.C.C., is solely for the propose stated in your letter. No other propose then the intended use will be agreed upon and a six month time limit will be placed upon stated use. At the end of the time limit, or the end of the experimental granted license, which ever comes first, N.E.W. will review this matter again and set in place a more formal agreement. This final agreement will only be placed if the F.C.C. grants Signatron Technology final approve to use frequencies requested and that no interference to station WMH560 is taken place.
