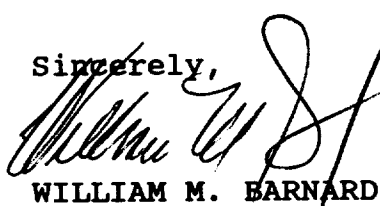

Dear Mr. Wright:

As you are aware, from the New England Wireless, Inc. ("NEW") experimental application and your meeting with our attorney, Mr. Barnard, NEW intends to commence wireless cable operations serving the Burlington, Vermont area with twenty three channels (twenty ITFS, three MDS). These twenty three channels will be offered as a basic program package, which in fact includes a movie channel (Showtime). These twenty three channels give us a rock bottom base for channel capacity allowing no room to experiment with program packages.

NEW is currently working with Vermont Educational Television to provide primary educational programming between the hours of 7 :00 a.m. and 5 p.m. and adult basic education after 5 p.m. New England Wireless has offered to provide VT ETV channel availability for this service at no charge but present channel capacity precludes such programming.

NEW would like the opportunity to experiment with different program packages on the eight channels requested. It is our hope to implement a "Family" package which will include a number of channels that will be directed toward the family environment, free of profanity and violence. In addition, it is our intent to include in this package some educational programs as well as family movies and history series. It is our belief that we will be the first cable company to offer such a package of quality family programming.

Unfortunately at this time we do not have the capacity of putting this and/or other packages on air due to our lack of channel capacity. Records show that there are no other facilities broadcasting on these frequencies within this market and it is our hope that these eight experimental licenses will be granted to New England Wireless.

Our projected subscriber potential for Mount Mansfield is based on direct line of site and channel carriage. We cannot be competitive with the cable companies in capturing a formidable subscriber base without our channel capacity. With twenty three channels we anticipate subscriber potential to be approximately 7,000. We feel with an additional eight channels our subscriber base could increase by 20%.
