**Re: Sprint Nextel Application for an Experimental Authorization
to Operate Channel F3 at the Greenville, SC, BMW Test Track**

The South Carolina Educational Television Commission ("SCETV") is the licensee of Educational Broadband Service ("EBS") Station WHN705 authorized to operate on the F Channel Group, including Channel F3 (2626-2632 MHz) in the Greenville, South Carolina, area. The geographic coverage area of Station WHN705 encompasses the test track located at the BMW plant in Greenville, South Carolina.

Sprint Nextel Corporation's wholly-owned subsidiary Nextel Spectrum Acquisition Corp. (collectively "Sprint Nextel") is the licensee of Broadband Radio Service ("BRS") Station B177 authorized to operate on Channel E3 (2620-2626 MHz). Station B177 has a geographic coverage area encompassing Basic Trading Area ("BTA") 177-Greenville-Spartanburg, SC, which includes the BMW test track (34-54-13N/82-10-58W). As indicated in the associated application for an Experimental Authorization, Sprint Nextel seeks authority to operate on Channel F3 in conjunction with its own adjacent Channel E3 in order to test certain proprietary WiMAX mobile wireless technology at the BMW test track.

SCETV hereby concurs with Sprint Nextel's application for an Experimental Authorization to operate on Channel F3 within a radius of approximately two miles of the BMW test track in Greenville, SC, through December 31, 2007. Sprint Nextel and SCETV will coordinate their respective operations to ensure there is no interference to either party, and SCETV does not anticipate any interference to its operations, but Sprint Nextel has assured SCETV that if any interference occurs, Sprint Nextel will cease use of Channel F3 until such interference can be identified and cured.

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Conditioned on that assurance, SCETV supports Sprint Nextel's application for an Experimental Authorization to operate on Channel F3 at the BMW test track through December 31, 2007.
