This Special Temporary Authorization is granted upon the express condition that it may be terminated by the Commission at any time without advance notice or hearing if in its discretion the need for such action arises. Nothing contained herein shall be construed as a finding by the Commission that the authority herein granted is or will be in the public interest beyond the express terms hereof.

This Special Temporary Authorization shall not vest in the grantee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequencies designated in the authorization beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. Neither the authorization nor the right granted hereunder shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the Communications Act of 1934. This authorization is subject to the right of use of control the Government of the United States conferred by Section 706 of the Communications Act of 1934.

- (2) The station identification requirements of Section 5.115 of the Commission's Rules are waived.

Special Conditions:

- (3) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (4) Stop Buzzer, Mr. William Cummings, phone: 571-230-3085 must be available during all testing to cease transmissions if required.
- (5) National Telecommunications and Information Administration concurs tests with the understanding that the licensee is trying to develop equipment that meets Part 15 GPR standards.
- (6) Request data on antenna and shielding.
- (7) Licensee needs to be aware that many federal operations, air traffic control, radars, satellite earth stations and radio astronomy could be interfered with if this system being developed for commercial use is not Part 15 compliant after testing.
- (8) All operations of this equipment need to be within one mile of the coordinates given.
