REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL TREATMENT

Pursuant to Section 0.459 of the Commission's Rules, NIITEK Inc. requests that certain aspects of its Application for Special Temporary Authority be treated confidentially. Information provided pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 0.459(b) is included below.

(1) Identification of the specific information for which confidential treatment is sought;

NIITEK Inc. requests confidential treatment for the proposed frequency use, emission characteristics, antenna beam width, and power output levels included in its STA application.

(2) Identification of the Commission proceeding in which the information was submitted or a description of the circumstances giving rise to the submission;

NIITEK Inc. is submitting this confidential information in connection with its STA Application for its ground penetrating radar technology, known as the DXD model.

(3) Explanation of the degree to which the information is commercial or financial, or contains a trade secret or is privileged;

The confidential information concerns development of a proprietary technology that is in its formative stages. The information is competitively sensitive. Disclosure of the information would provide an advantage to NIITEK's competitors.

(4) Explanation of the degree to which the information concerns a service that is subject to competition;

The information concerns a service that is subject to competition.

(5) Explanation of how disclosure of the information could result in substantial competitive harm;

Disclosure of this information could result in substantial competitive harm to NIITEK because it would enable NIITEK's competitors to obtain information about a technology that is still in its formative stages.

(6) Identification of any measures taken by the submitting party to prevent unauthorized disclosure;

NIITEK has not disclosed the proposed frequency use, emission characteristics, antenna beam width, and power output levels to persons outside the company or to persons other than those that owe a fiduciary duty to the company.

(7) Identification of whether the information is available to the public and the extent of any previous disclosure of the information to third parties;

Information about NIITEK's DXD model is not available to the public.

(8) Justification of the period during which the submitting party asserts that material should not be available for public disclosure; and

NIITEK seeks to keep this information confidential unless or until NIITEK engages in a public contract with an entity for use of NIITEK's ground penetrating radar technology.

(9) Any other information that the party seeking confidential treatment believes may be useful in assessing whether its request for confidentiality should be granted.
