This Special Temporary Authorization is granted upon the express condition that it may be terminated by the Commission at any time without advance notice or hearing if in its discretion the need for such action arises. Nothing contained herein shall be construed as a finding by the Commission that the authority herein granted is or will be in the public interest beyond the express terms hereof.

This Special Temporary Authorization shall not vest in the grantee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequencies designated in the authorization beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. Neither the authorization nor the right granted hereunder shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the Communications Act of 1934. This authorization is subject to the right of use of control the Government of the United States conferred by Section 706 of the Communications Act of 1934.

Special Conditions:

- (2) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (3) No operations are used the frequency band 1715-1720 MHz.
- (4) Required monthly coordination between Department of Justice, Department of Homeland Security and Nokia to schedule testing areas and times prior to operating.
- (5) No testing for using the frequency band 1710-1715 MHz is allowed until coordinated with

- (6) - Department of Justice must be notified four days in advance to when the actual testing is to start at:

 - Carolyn.J.Thomas@usdoj.gov- A test plan showing locations of cell sites of where hand set testing is occurring is required.
- (7) Nokia must be aware that testing operations can be required to shut down at any time for periods of several days if government operations are required on short notice.
- (8) Stop buzzer, Richard Haley, phone (405) 751-3525, name and phone must provide to Department of Justice and Department of Homeland Security one week in advance of testing and must be available to turn off the testing if required at all times.
- (9) Operation is subject to prior coordination with Fixed Microwave licensees and affected existing and future Advanced Wireless Services (AWS) licensees.
