A station authorization for experimental radio service is needed in order to conduct performance and integration testing on Personal Communication Service (PCS) equipment. The radio portion of PCS equipment consists of a Base Transceiver Station (BTS) and a Mobile Station (MS). The BTS transmits in the 1930-1990 MHz band while the MS transmits in the 1850-1910 MHz band. The information transmitted is digital and the modulation technique is Gaussian Minimum Shift Keying (GMSK) at a rate of 270.833 kbaud.

The overall objective of the program is to verify the performance of upgrades and enhancements to the PCS system. These tests will include, but not be limited to, new software release testing, cell coverage enhancement testing, and integration testing with other vendor equipment. These tests will enable Nokia to continue to make advances in the PCS field that will benefit Nokia, the service providers, and ultimately the public.
