Northrop Grumman Corporation ("Northrop Grumman") hereby requests a 180-day grant of Special Temporary Authority ("STA") to operate the airborne experimental station facility specified in the pending Form 442 application for a new experimental radio station (File No. 0 - EX-PL-2002), which Northrop Grumman filed with the Commission on April 23, 2002. See Northrop Grumman's pending Form 442 application (File No. 0 -EX-PL-2002), which is attached.

Northrop Grumman is developing a new radar transmitter capable of 6 inch resolution and plans to use the facility specified in the pending Form 442 application to test and evaluate the new transmitter as well as collect target data and perform a proof of concept. Testing of the new radar transmitter is scheduled to commence on May 30, 2002. Therefore, in order to ensure that testing begins as scheduled so that Northrop Grumman is able to complete its development in a timely manner so that it can meet potential consumer demand for the new product, Northrop Grumman respectfully requests a grant of STA from the Commission on or before May 30, 2002 for a term lasting 180 days or until the underlying Form 442 application is acted on by the FCC.

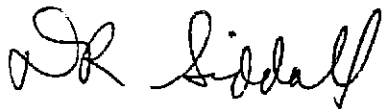

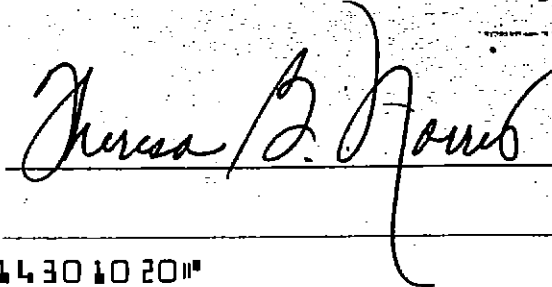
