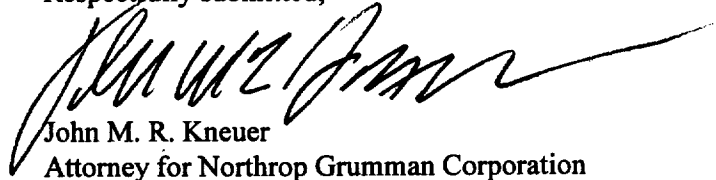
Dear Ms. Secretary:
