The band request 963.8-1708.3 MHz has the potential to interfere with FAA spectrum. It is recommended to select a spot frequency (rather than band assignment) outside the FAA spectrum.

Narrowbanding has been requested for 139.5-143.435 MHz, 149.05-150.04 MHz and 409.25-449.25 MHz. Please report bandwidths less than 12.5 kHz in your response to this correspondence as opposed to the 15 kHz and 42 kHz bandwidths that have been requested for these bands.

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of June 02, 2008 may result in application dismissal pursuant to Section 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to Section 1.1108.
