- (1) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.

- (2) The station identification requirements of Section 5.115 of the Commission's Rules are waived.
- (3) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.

- (5) Operation in the 1850-1990 MHz band requires prior frequency coordination with 2 GHz microwave users and consent of PCS licensees to avoid interference.
- (6) Licensee is required to coordinate operations with existing microwave and satellite users in the area to avoid interference.
- (7) This STA is only approved for the time period set forth above which is different than the time period requested.
