

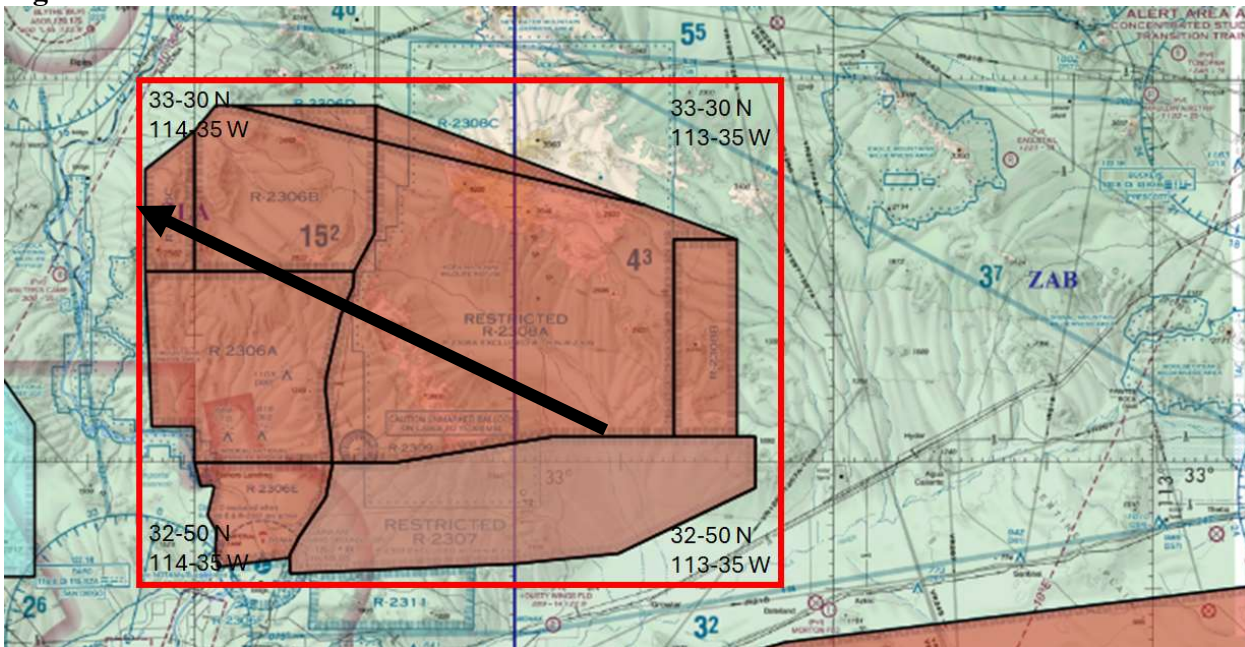
EXH. 1 - REQUEST FOR EXPERIMENTAL LICENSE

Northrop Grumman Systems Corporation ("NGSC") hereby requests an experimental license¹ to enable experimental flight testing and demonstration to a potential government customer of a Developmental, Prototype eight Tile Array (AESA) and one Digital Array Interface Unit (DAIU). The DAIU includes the Reference generator, Processor, Recorder and Digital Antenna Data Manager.

The flight testing will take place in government-controlled airspace (warning areas and MOAs). This is an area bounded as shown in the map illustration of Figure 1 at Yuma Proving Ground, Arizona and includes restricted areas 2306A, 2306B, 2306C, 2306E, 2307, 2308A, 2308B, 2308C and 2311. The test aircraft will remain in US Airspace and will not cross the international border with Mexico.
