Carl,

On the various questions you asked Wednesday afternoon and per our talk on Thursday, here is the information you were looking for:

File # 0184-EX-ST-2004 Locations: Linthicum and Webster Airfield

Yes, they need the entire frequency range of 8.5 - 9.8 GHz, including the 9.3 - 9.5 GHz that you were in question about. The PRF for this job is 1 kHz to 1.5 kHz and the PW is 100 uSec. The altitude that they plan to fly and test at is 20,000 feet. Remember, Webster Airfield is in restricted airspace.

File # 0185-EX-ST-2004 Location: Norwalk, CT

They plan to do testing at 9.5 GHz, 9.65 GHz and at 9.7 GHz. The bandwidth is 100 MHz. The PRF for this job is 1 kHz to 4 kHz and the Max PW is 100 uSec.
