Dear Mr. Jan Sochurek:

Pursuant to our telephone conversation today, August 10, 2005, is it possible to enclose the zones 1, 2 and 3 within rectangle(s) described by two lines of latitude and two lines longitude, or enclose the zones 1, 2 and 3 within circle(s) described by a center geographical coordinate and a radius in kilometers? Please note that the two circles that describe zone 4 and the Georgetown, Delaware area may already contain portions of zones 1, 2, and 3.

Also, please report the maximum altitude at which transmissions will be made, and please report the peak effective radiated powers (ERPs) as opposed to the mean ERPs.

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of August 10, 2005 may result in application dismissal pursuant to Section 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to Section 1.1108.
