

Request for Experimental Authorization

Northrop Grumman Systems Corporation ("Northrop Grumman") requests a 2-year Experimental Authorization to replace Special Temporary Authority ("STA") WE9XRB to continue testing of Tactical Targeting Network Technology, a Mini-Tactical Common Data Link Surface Terminal and a Mini-Tactical Common Data Link Airborne Terminal pursuant to a U.S. Army Contract.

These tests are pursuant to U.S. Army Contract No. W91260-10-9-0005. The equipment, which will be operated in a lab environment, includes the Tactical Targeting Network Technology ("TTNT") manufactured by Rockwell Collins, and a Mini-Tactical Common Data Link Surface and a Mini-Tactical Common Data Link Airborne Terminal ("CDLs") manufactured by Cubic. TTNT is a high-bandwidth wireless network designed to assist the U.S. military in creating a rapid retargeting capability. The data links are adaptable to a variety of configurations.
