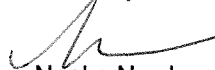
Dear DS LAW PLLC,

This refers to application, File No. 0773-EX-ST-2016, for an experimental authorization.

You are advised that the Commission is unable to grant your application for the facilities requested. The band 2200-2290 MHz is allocated for federal space operations, fixed and mobile (line of sight only) and the band congestion, emission bandwidth, and flight level combination have resulted in the inability to provide the requested 20 MHz emission channels. If the testing is for a Department of Defense contract, NTIA suggests that a military sponsor be acquired and have frequency requests submitted thru the sponsor.
