Your frequency request is too broad. We cannot coordinate the entire 1710-1990 MHz and the FCC cannot choose frequencies for you. Anything in 1710-1755 MHz will require you to get consent from affected Advanced Wireless Services (AWS) licensees. Anything in 1850-1990 MHz will require you to get consent from affected Personal Communications Services (PCS) licensees. Anything in 1755-1850 MHz will require us to coordinate with Federal Government users. You will need to narrow down your request significantly, taking those factors into concern.

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of November 15, 2013 may result in application dismissal pursuant to Section 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to Section 1.1108.
