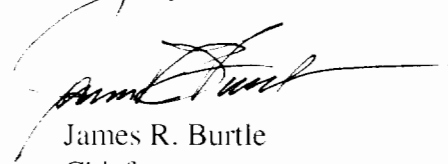
Dear Stewart Cobb,
