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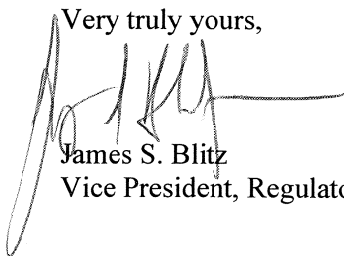

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Dr. Aloï:

This letter provides XM Satellite Radio's ("XM") conditional consent for Oakland University ("OU") to broadcast in the frequency spectrum from 2332.5 MHz to 2450.0 MHz, explicitly for antenna range testing for the purposes and pursuant to the specifications detailed in OU's application for an experimental license to the Federal Communications Commission (FCC File Number 0133-EX-PL-2007). XM reserves the right to withdraw this consent at any time, in the event that XM believes that OU's operations under this license create any interference to XM's customers or XM's authorized use of this frequency band. Should XM withdraw its consent on this basis, OU will immediately discontinue its operations under this experimental license.
