Special Conditions:

- (1) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (2) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (3) Licensee shall remove or notch out Band 14 from this STA. The area of proposed spectrum use is currently covered by NPSBN Band 14. Findings are explained to STA POC Scott Beadell.
- (4) Prior to commencing any operations in the frequencies below, the applicant must obtain consent from the following within 50 miles of the contours of the testing area:
700 MHz Lower Band licensees (698-746 MHz)
700 MHz Upper Band licensees (746-758 MHz and 775-788 MHz)
Cellular licensees (824-849 MHz/869-894 MHz)
Broadband PCS licensees (1850-1910 MHz/1930-1990 MHz)
- (5) Licensee shall secure consents from the Advance Wireless Service licensees prior to accessing to 1710-1785 MHz band.
