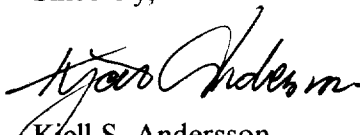

("OTI") hereby requests renewal of OTI's Special Temporary Authorization (call sign KS2XAO, file number S-3054-EX-97) to operate spread spectrum wireless communications equipment in and around Colorado Springs, Colorado for an additional six-month period. OTI requires this STA renewal to continue its evaluation and resolution of interference problems that may arise from operating GSM equipment in the same geographic area as the IS661 equipment OTI is developing. OTI's agreement with the F-band license holder for Colorado Springs (OTI's sister company, Omnipoint Colorado Springs F License, LLC) will permit OTI to operate in the F-band throughout the STA renewal period.
