

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN THE ORANGETOWN POLICE DEPARTMENT
AND BOROUGH OF NORWOOD POLICE DEPARTMENT
FOR UTILIZATION OF PUBLIC SAFETY
INTEROPERABLE COMMUNICATIONS TECHNOLOGY

1. **PARTIES:** The parties to this Agreement are the Orangetown Police Department and Borough of Norwood Police Department.
2. **AUTHORITY:** This Agreement is authorized as provided for by the United States Department of Justice, the National Institute of Justice, the federal Communications Commission, and any applicable laws, statutes, and provisions.
3. **PURPOSE:** The purpose of this Agreement is to set forth terms by which timely, direct, two-way voice communications between public safety agencies may be established in the interest of communicative interoperability between and among such agencies to enhance delivery of law enforcement and other public safety services.
4. **RESPONSIBILITIES:**
 - a. The Orangetown Police Department will be responsible for the acquisition of equipment associated with this project. There is no cost to any other agency for participation in this project.
 - b. The Orangetown Police Department will operate the equipment in accord with FCC Rules and Regulations, and the operational guidelines established by the Department of Justice and related sponsor agencies.
 - c. The Orangetown Police Department will use the project technology as a testbed to analyze issues of interoperability between and among participating agencies.
 - d. When using the interoperability system, participants will identify themselves as using a basic English language protocol such as "Agency XXX", where "XXX" is the standard call sign for a specific mobile, vessel, portable, or aviation radio. For example, Orangetown car 3328 would identify itself as ORANGETOWN 3328".
 - e. Plain language will serve as the basis for all communication when interoperability technology is employed. Police codes and/or signals will not be used.
 - f. Training and operational protocol materials will be made available to participating. The integrity of the system will be tested on a recurring basis.

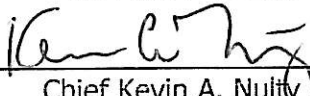
5. **OTHER PROVISIONS:** Nothing in this Agreement is intended to conflict with current law or regulation or the directives of any of the parties. If a term of this agreement is inconsistent with such authority, then that shall be invalid subject to conflict of laws principles, but the remaining terms and conditions of this agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
6. **EFFECTIVE DATE:** This agreement will become effective on or about October 1, 2006.
7. **MODIFICATION:** This agreement can only be modified by mutual consent of the parties involved or as needed to stay compliant with FCC regulations.
8. **TERMINATION:** Participating agencies each reserve the right to terminate their participation in this project upon 30 days written notice to the Orangetown Police Department
9. Unless modified as provided for herein, this agreement shall survive the office terms of participating agency personnel, remaining in full force and effect with their successors.
