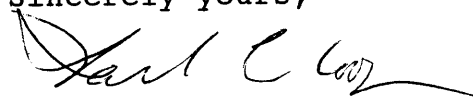
Dear Mr. Wright:

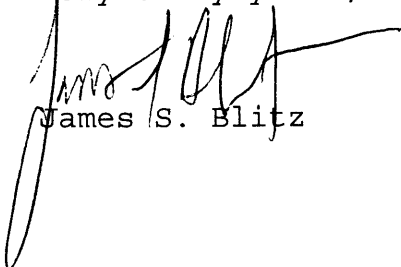
