Re: Application of PacifiCorp for Experimental STA on VHF Public Coast Frequencies
in the 157 and 161 MHz Bands

Dear Sir or Madam:

MariTEL, Inc., parent of MariTEL Northern Pacific, Inc. and MariTEL Southern Pacific, Inc., understands that PacifiCorp is requesting an experimental Special Temporary Authorization (“STA”) to use certain VHF Public Coast (“VPC”) frequencies licensed to MariTEL; specifically, 157.2625 – 157.2875 MHz and 161.8625 – 161.8875 MHz in the State of Oregon within 20 miles of the Pacific Ocean and/or the Columbia River. MariTEL is the current licensee of this spectrum under Call Signs WPOJ532 and WPOJ536.

MariTEL has no objection to PacifiCorp’s use of this spectrum as proposed in its application for STA (File No. 0404-EX-STA-2012). MariTEL does not anticipate any disruption to its maritime operations from PacifiCorp’s plan of experimentation and will coordinate with PacifiCorp to ensure that co-channel interference is avoided or mitigated.
