Narrative statement describing the government project, agency, and contact number:

PAR Rome Research Corporation is developing a standards-based, software defined radio (SDR) capable of providing interoperable communications between public safety and law enforcement agencies with disparate voice and data radio systems. The Software Adaptive Advanced Communications (SAACTM) system is an SDR designed to provide mobile radio interoperability between disparate platforms – without the need to modify or replace existing radio systems. The SAACTM System has completed Alpha testing and is being readied for field trials.
