This Special Temporary Authorization is granted upon the express condition that it may be terminated by the Commission at any time without advance notice or hearing if in its discretion the need for such action arises. Nothing contained herein shall be construed as a finding by the Commission that the authority herein granted is or will be in the public interest beyond the express terms hereof.

This Special Temporary Authorization shall not vest in the grantee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequencies designated in the authorization beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. Neither the authorization nor the right granted hereunder shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the Communications Act of 1934. This authorization is subject to the right of use of control the Government of the United States conferred by Section 706 of the Communications Act of 1934.

Special Temporary Authority is hereby granted to operate the apparatus described below:

This operation will train, evaluate and certify Naval Special Warfare maneuver units prior to overseas deployments.

## Special Conditions:

- (1) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (2) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (3) This authorization SUPERSEDES the previously issued authorization with the same call sign and file number:
- (4) Licensee shall not transmit or operate in the 4950-4990 MHz band.
- (5) Operations within part 90 bands must comply with all applicable rules under part 90, including, but not limited to, the requirements for protecting centralized trunked incumbents as specified in section 90.187.
- (6) Transmissions overlapping the 9350-9417.5 MHz range are not permitted within 60 km of 34° 22' 55" N 117° 40' 55" W.
- (7) Transmissions overlapping the 9405-9415 MHz range are not permitted within 83 km of 32° 53' 30" N 116° 25' 22" W.
- (8) Transmissions overlapping the 9315-9375 MHz range are not permitted within 58 km of 33° 21' 21" N 116° 51' 50" W.
- (9) Licensee must not transmit within 24 nautical miles of [(32° 44' 01" N) (117° 11' 23" W)] (San Diego Airport)
- (10) Licensee must not transmit within 27 nautical miles of [(33° 40' 32" N) (117° 52' 06" W)] (Santa Ana Airport)

**Special Conditions:**

- (11) Prior to any transmissions that overlap either of the 9596-9604 MHz or 9616-9624 MHz frequency ranges, licensee must successfully coordinate with and receive explicit written concurrence from the NASA GSFC Spectrum Office at NASA-DL-GSFC-Spectrum-Management@mail.nasa.gov. Without explicit written agreement prior to the commencement of operations, transmissions overlapping the 9596-9604 MHz or 9616-9624 MHz ranges are not permitted.
