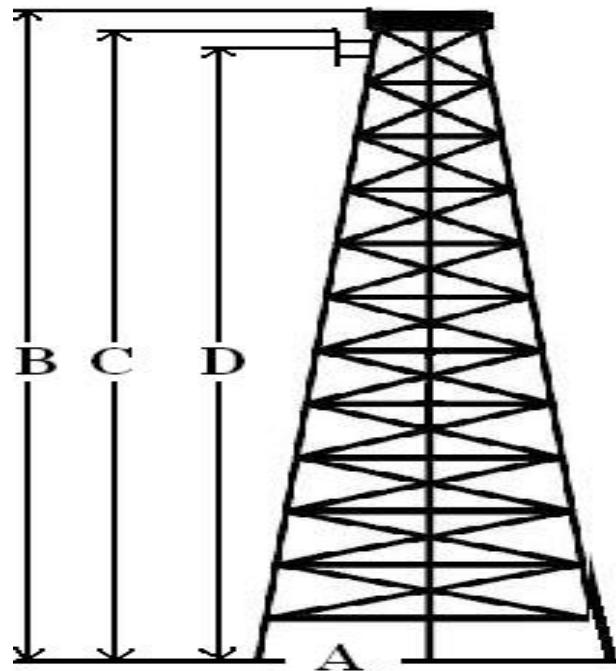


The following pages contain information provided for informational purposes pertaining to the actual installation of the antenna system to be used during these operations in the 3650 - 3700 MHz band.
