Subject: 0505-EX-ST-2009 / Conditional Concurrence

NTIA conditionally concurs with the Federal Communications Commission Special Temporary Authorization (STA) requested by Patriot Technologies for Gulfport, MS. during the period 1 December 2009 thru 1 June 2010 under the following conditions.

1. Notify the applicant that the FAA will not procure this equipment in this band.
2. The FAA will not allow this equipment to be used operationally for aviation safety by any entity.
3. This concurrence is based upon the understanding that this license is for proof of concept only.
4. It should be noted that Coast Guard operates 9300 – 9500 MHz in the Gulfport area. This operations should be protected from interference.
