The Pennsylvania State University is requesting a SPECIAL TEMPORARY AUTHORITY to operate an experimental authorization, until our filed application can be granted for the facility shown on the copy of the application attached. The reason for this request is that we are working with the Department of the Navy on a very sensitive project and the need for this Temporary Authority is urgent for the development and completion of the project.

Per our application we are requesting the frequency 9375 MHz, located at our Research Laboratory in University Park, Pa. and the work will be restricted to the project mentioned above in paragraph one (1). The location is at the coordinates of 40-47-33/077-52-09. The antenna will be mounted on the top of a van, thus meeting the 20 ft. rule as set forth by Commission Rules and Regulations. Our power is shown in question four (4) and all other technical information is set forth in the application.

Because of the sensitivity and secure nature of the work with the Department of the Navy, obviously the rapid response of the Commission is requested and appreciated.
