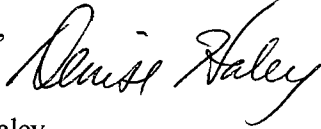
Dear Sir or Madam:

Per 47 CFR 0.459 concerning requests that materials or information submitted to the Commission be withheld from public inspection, Philips Medical Systems would like to provide the following information:

- 1) The specific information for which confidentiality is sought are the exhibits labeled "Form 422 Question 7 from Sept 2006", "Letter dated 9 January 2007, Additional Info" and "Letter dated 3 January 2008, Additional Info".
- 2) Philips Medical Systems in Andover, Massachusetts and Bothell, Washington conduct R&D activities for medical devices. The reason for this submission is to allow testing of radio components/products that might not currently have an FCC Grant (as we may choose vendors that only provide radio chips and not modules or end products).
- 3) Philips believes that this information is privileged because some of the final design is intended to be patented by Philips.
- 4) Philips Medical Systems considers confidentiality of this submission significant.
- 5) Disclosure of our Experimental License details to the competition could significantly impact patents and intellectual property (and associated revenues) as well as our marketing strategy.
- 6) Communications on some wireless applications with regard to Philips Medical Systems products have not been publicly disclosed.
- 7) Formal communications to potential suppliers or other parties have been conducted via a Philips Non-Disclosure Agreement for confidentiality.
- 8) Based on the delay of some wireless products in the commercial market and the amount of time required from feasibility tests to working wireless prototypes, we would like to request confidentiality through December 2009.
- 9) Aside from the information above, there is no additional information to provide at this time.
