This Special Temporary Authorization is granted upon the express condition that it may be terminated by the Commission at any time without advance notice or hearing if in its discretion the need for such action arises. Nothing contained herein shall be construed as a finding by the Commission that the authority herein granted is or will be in the public interest beyond the express terms hereof.

This Special Temporary Authorization shall not vest in the grantee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequencies designated in the authorization beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. Neither the authorization nor the right granted hereunder shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the Communications Act of 1934. This authorization is subject to the right of use of control the Government of the United States conferred by Section 706 of the Communications Act of 1934.

Special Temporary Authority is hereby granted to operate the apparatus described below:

The purpose of the operation is to test ultra-wideband technology used for proximity data transmission in certain transportation applications.

Special Conditions:

- (1) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (2) This authorization SUPERSEDES the previously issued authorization with the same call sign and file number:
- (3) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (4) All customers participating in the experiment shall be informed that this operation is for experimental purposes only and can be cancelled at any time.

- (6) The authorized station must be in compliance with the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) requirements as set forth in Section 17.4 of the Commission's Rules.
- (7) The authorized station must be in compliance with environmental requirement set forth in Section 1.1307 of the Commission's Rules.
- (8) Experimental station shall use the minimum power level necessary to establish communications links to minimize potential interference to licensed users.
- (9) This authorization is without prejudice to any determination that the Commission may make regarding pending or future experimental satellite earth station applications.
- (10) Operations are on a non-interference basis (NIB) and shall not cause harmful interference to, and shall not claim protection from, interference caused to it by any other lawfully operating station and it shall cease transmission(s) immediately upon notice of such interference and notify the FCC in writing.
- (11) Licensee shall maintain operation separation from the grandfathered earth stations as defined in Part 90, Subpart Z, or coordinate an agreement with the grandfathered earth station licensees prior to operation in 3650-3700 MHz band.
- (12) Licensee shall consult the ULS database to ensure that the operation will not cause harmful interference to any existing registered stations in the 3650-3700 MHz band, and notify the registered users in the proposed geographic areas prior to operation in this band.

Special Conditions:

- (13) Licensee shall coordinate with the local SBE frequency coordinator and the Fixed Microwave Service licensees prior to operation in 6.2-6.74 GHz band.
- (14) Concurrence for 30 days at a time; extensions will be considered on a case by case basis.
- (15) Operations to be limited during the work week (M-F -- excluding Federal Holidays) and work hours (8:00am-5:00pm EST).
- (16) Notification required 24 hours prior to intent to radiate for scheduling.
- (17) Notification required prior to scheduled radiation.
- (18) Notification required upon completion of radiation.

- (20) To the maximum extent possible, utilize sensing equipment (e.g. Spectrum analyzer) during radiation.
