NTIA conditionally concurs with the Federal Communications Commission Special Temporary Authorization (STA) requested by Plextek for McKinney, TX., Torrey Pines, CA., Dulzura, CA., Port Hueneme, CA., Imperial Beach, CA., Point Loma, CA., Goleta, CA., and Douglas, AZ. during the period 15 May 2012 thru 15 November 2012 under the following conditions:

1. Ensure emissions do not radiate below 16.2 GHz
2. Plextek must coordinate with the Western Area Frequency Coordinator (WAFC), Mr. J. Szelog at (760) 939-6948 prior to any California operations and must comply with any restrictions that may be levied.
