Thank you for your time on the phone earlier this week.

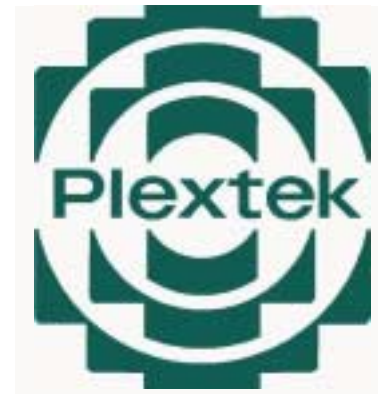

STA Application 0573-EX-ST-2006 – Blighter 202 Radar System

Further to our conversation of 10 Oct last we wish to provide a little more background information for our application (originally submitted on 3 Aug 2006), hoping that this will make FCC consideration of the application more straightforward.

We are hoping that we will not need more such Special Temporary Applications after this, since our Blighter 202 radar system is presently undergoing the FCC approval procedure in the UK, trials having taken place and documents forwarded to the TCB who are presently reviewing it (under FCC ID No. "UFQ-Blighter-202").

We have also updated some of the technical information presented within this STA (such as the Emissions Designator), to better reflect the specification of this unit, hopefully making assessment simpler.

We will not need to operate this unit for more than a few hours on a few days at each location within the period requested, but at present are unable to arrange/determine suitable dates, partly due to not knowing when we may get STA approval, so prefer to leave the window of possibility as wide as possible meantime.

We are requesting this STA, prior to full FCC approval, to enable us to demonstrate this equipment to various interested parties within the US, including DOD and DHS Departments interested in its use for Military and Security applications.

We trust this additional information will be useful and hope it will simplify the process of consideration.
