Mr. Bron Tamulion,

Pursuant to our telephone conversation today, April 28, 2009, please submit:

(1.) a description of the experiment.

(2.) the name and phone number (preferably cell phone number) of a stop buzzer, someone who is available at all times and can cease transmissions immediately should interference occur.

(3.) calculations in accordance with NTIA Manual 8.3.28 which states that the maximum equivalent isotropically radiated power (EIRP) must be such that the calculated emissions are no greater than -140 dBm/24 MHz as received by an isotropic antenna at a distance of 100 feet (30 meters) from the building where the test is being conducted. The calculations showing compliance with this requirement must be provided with the application for frequency assignment and should be based on free space propagation with no allowance for additional attenuation (e.g., building attenuation).

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of April 28, 2009 may result in application dismissal pursuant to Section 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to Section 1.1108.
