

Exhibit 2 – Environmental and MPE Certification

The proposed antenna test range does not fall under any of the categories of facilities that may have a significant environmental impact under §1.1307(a) of the FCC rules.

Because Prodelin is applying to use effective radiated power (ERP) greater than 100 W under Part 5 of the FCC rules, the test range transmissions require environmental evaluation for human exposure to radio frequency radiation under §1.1307(b). Prodelin has completed RF exposure calculations for the test range and certifies that the Maximum Permissible Exposure limits of §1.1310 will not be exceeded under the requested terms of the experimental license. As required by §1.1307(b), Prodelin will provide its calculations to the Commission upon request.

Because the proposed antenna test range does not fall under any of the categories of facilities that may have a significant environmental impact under §1.1307(a), and the test range operations will not exceed the Maximum Permissible Exposure limits of §1.1310, Prodelin is not required to file an Environmental Assessment (EA) as part of this application.
